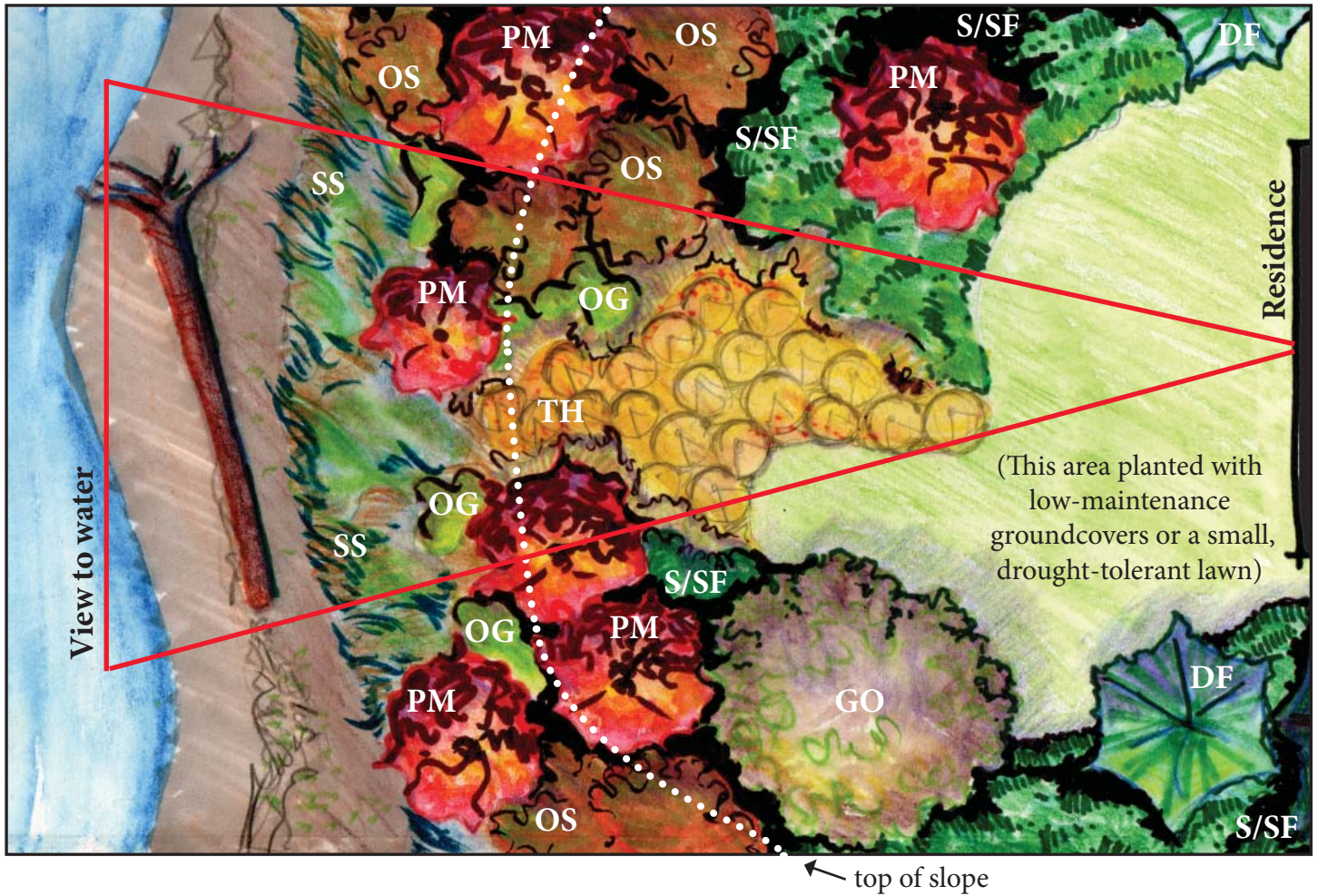


SAMPLE PLANTING PLAN: MARINE SHORELINE
